Cool Treats pg 32

Cardstock and Ink:

Pool Party, Chocolate Chip, Peekaboo Peach, Sweet Sugarplum, Crumb Cake, and Whisper White Cardstock

Sweet Sugarplum, Chocolate Chip, Pool Party, and Peekaboo Peach inks

Sweet Sugarplum Glitter paper (SaleABration Gift)

Silver Foil

Window Sheets

Other:

Frozen Treats Dies (or buy as a bundle with the stamps)

Lace Doilies

Sprinkles Embellishments

Fine Tip Glue

Festive Embossing Folder

In-Colour Enamel Dots

Instructions:

1. Emboss the front of the card (in two pieces) with the folder of your choice. You can lightly brush with the Whisper White ink if you'd like.
2. Fold your Whisper White in half and position inside the Pool Party card base without adhering. Lay the right hand side of the Pool Party card base where it will sit. Use this position as a guide to stamp the "You're Cool". Stamp Cool first and then You're.
3. Adhere the acetate to the back of the Pool Party card front to create a complete card front.
4. Cut your lace doily piece in half and adhere each piece to the Glitter Paper so it sits where you want it on the final product. Trim. Adhere to the card front.
5. Adhere the Chocolate Chip strips inside the card to hide the acetate join. You can also choose to have the Chocolate Chip pieces showing through the acetate just a little bit.
6. Assembly your ice cream sundae: Adhere the chocolate sauce to three scoops of ice cream. Adhere the spoon to the bowl. Assemble the ice creams. Adhere the entire assembly to the card front as shown.
7. Open card front and adhere the remaining ice cream pieces to the back of the ice cream sundae to hide the adhesive. You may emboss the crumb cake bowl if you wish.
8. Finish stamping inside the card and stamp your envelope.
9. Tie the twine around your card spine and add three enamel dots to the card front.
10. Lightly cover the chocolate sauce with the Fine Tip Glue Pen and drop sprinkles into it (one by one). Let dry thoroughly.
