

# Z Fold Joyful Season Card

Demonstrated by Jacque Williams

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Supplies:

**Stamp** – Joyful Season

**Ink** - Basic Black Archival, Cherry Cobbler, Soft Suede, Daffodil Delight

**Card Stock** Whisper White (WW), Soft Sky (SS), Cherry

#1 SS – 4" x 5 ¾",  
WW – 4 1/8" x 5 7/8"

#2 SS – 4" x 4 1/8",  
WW – 4 1/8" x 4 ¼"

#3 WW – 3 5/8" x length of A4 Card stock,

#4 WW – 4 ½" x 3", Cherry – 4 5/8" x 3 1/8"

**Other** – Brick Wall Embossing Folder,

Gold Cording Trim (20cm), Bitty Banner Framelits, Expressions Elements (wood words), In Colour Washi Tape, Home for Christmas Enamel Dots



1. Emboss the two Soft Sky panels and lightly ink with Soft Suede or other brown ink of your choice. Adhere to the two Whisper White card bases.
2. Score the long White panel into thirds and fold. Stamp the sentiment of your choice and the branch and berries. Adhere between the two panels as shown and add two enamel dots in the corners.
3. On the card front panel, stamp the branch in Soft Suede ink. Stamp the bird outline in Basic Black and the bird fill in Cherry Cobbler. Stamp the beak in Daffodil Delight. Add a strip of Washi Tape in any colour of your choice and add your wooden work to the front, allowing the word to "hang off" the end if you wish. (don't put glue on the last couple of letters in this case!)
4. Stamp the word Christmas onto the scrap piece and die cut with the Itty Bitty Banners Die (or scissor cut if you prefer). Curl slightly and adhere to the card front.
5. Wrap the gold cord around the panel three times and tie into a neat knot. Adhere panel to the card front with three dimensionals on the left hand side.
6. Stamp your envelope as desired.
