Stamps:

Hello, sailor
Hardwood Background stamp
World Map Background stamp

Cardstock:

Brushed Gold Cardstock
Soft Suede Cardstock
Very Vanilla Cardstock

Other:

Basic Pearls
Gold Twine
Neutrals Candy Dots
Little Labels Punch Pack
Early Espresso Embossing Powder
Versamark
Black STaz-On
Encore Gold Ink pad
Sponges
Envelope Punch board
Soft Suede and/or Crumb Cake Ink pad



Instructions:

1. Fold the Soft Suede card not quite in half and punch to create the file folder shape as shown by the demonstrators using the envelope punch board. You can also view a video at <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=oxsPHEoKto4>. Cut your very vanilla insert the same way.
2. Stamp the Soft Suede panel with Versamark with the Hardwood stamp and emboss with Early Espresso Embossing powder. Sponge all edges of all pieces with Soft Suede ink.
3. Stamp both Very Vanilla pieces with the Word Map stamp in Crumb Cake ink. Tear one side of the smaller piece and roll the other to make it appear like an old map. Sponge. Stamp the Sentiment in Black STaz-On from the Hello, Sailor stamp set. Add pearls. Knot the Gold Twine; position as pictured.
4. Punch four label punches from the centre of your Brushed Gold cardstock. Layer all pieces as shown, sponging edges as desired. Trim the label punches in half and add a candy dot.
5. Stamp the anchor in Gold ink on Basic Black card and punch using the banner punch. Adhere to the inner and also stamp the ship wheel in Black Staz-On. Close the sides up of the Suede file folder using Sticky Strip on each side if desired.
