

{WHITE CHRISTMAS RESIST}

Supplies

Stamps: White Christmas

Ink: Versamark, Pink Pirouette, Soft Sky

Card/Paper: Whisper White Thick Cardstock, Shimmer White

Accessories: Metallic Sequins, Basic Rhinestones, Stapler, Silver Metallic Thread, White Embossing Powder, Silver Metallic thread

Tools: Heat Tool, Small Banner Punch, Envelope Punch Board

Instructions

1. Stamp the tree image in versamark and heat emboss in white. You may wish to stamp a fourth tree in between the existing trees and emboss again.



2. Create a mask for the area below the treeline, using the stamp on a scrap paper and cutting to create the mask. Sponge Pink Pirouette lightly at the bottom horizon. Sponge Soft Sky throughout the sky area.



3. Adhere to the Whisper White mat, roughing up the edges with your scissor blade if you wish.



4. Stamp and heat emboss in silver the sentiment. Create a banner shape with your scissors. Place a glue dot behind the word strip and loop the silver metallic thread around as desired. Staple to the card front.



5. Adhere the stamped image to the card front using dimensionals. Adhere five rhinestones and four sequins to the card front as desired.
6. Stamp the inside of your card as desired. (I heat embossed in silver the second set of words contained in the White Christmas stamp set).
