	COLOURED CARDSTOCK & THICK WHITE	WHISPER WHITE VERY VANILLA	KRAFT	SHIMMERY WHITE	VELLUM	WATERCOLOUR PAPER
HEAT EMBOSSING	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes; use lower heat setting as vellum tends to warp	Yes
