## Big Shot Sandwiches Reference Sheet

### **Dies:**

[Framelits:](#) Dies with an open centre, such as circles or any open shapes.

[Thinlits or Detailed Dies:](#) Dies with details, such as a detailed flower or butterfly. Best to use with a Precision Plate and use the Die Brush for easy removal.

[Standard Embossing Folders:](#) Standard texture impression in a wide variety of patterns. Available in A5 or 6x6 sizes.

[3D Dynamic Textured Impressions Embossing Folders:](#) Dynamic folders create a deep, dimensional embossed impression. Good practice to lightly spritz with water for the deepest impression.

### **Plates:**

[Standard Cutting Pads:](#) Acrylic plates used for both die cutting and embossing. One set is included in the purchase of the Big Shot.

[Precision Base Plate:](#) Hard, black plate used UNDER any detailed dies (Thinlits) to improve cardstock being embedded into the die and better cutting. Framelits will eventually snap if used repeatedly with the Precision Base Plate.

[Magnetic Platform:](#) This platform is magnetic to help dies stay in place when cutting around images. Not recommended to use in conjunction with the Precision Base Plate.

[Big Shot Standard Platform:](#) Included with the purchase of a Big Shot. Slightly raised centre for better cutting over time. The Standard Platform has two pieces – the base and another layer for framelits and Thinlits.

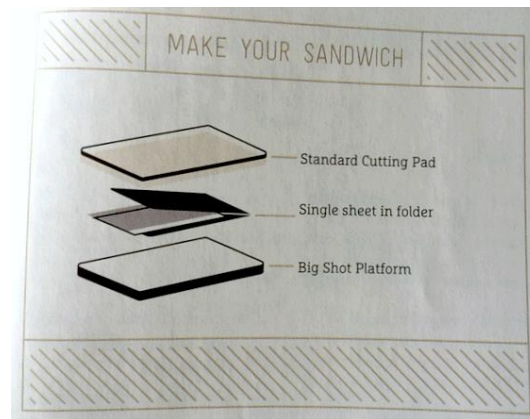
[Big Shot Die Brush:](#) Easily removes small cut pieces from intricate dies. Includes one brush and two foam pads.

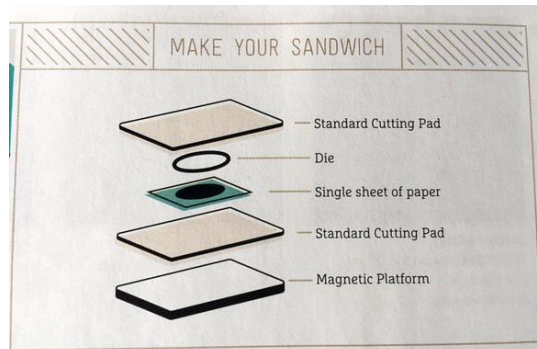
