



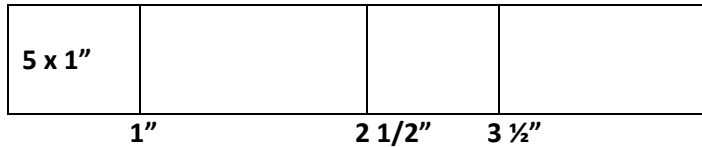
Basic Crossover Pop Up Card Template

Portrait:

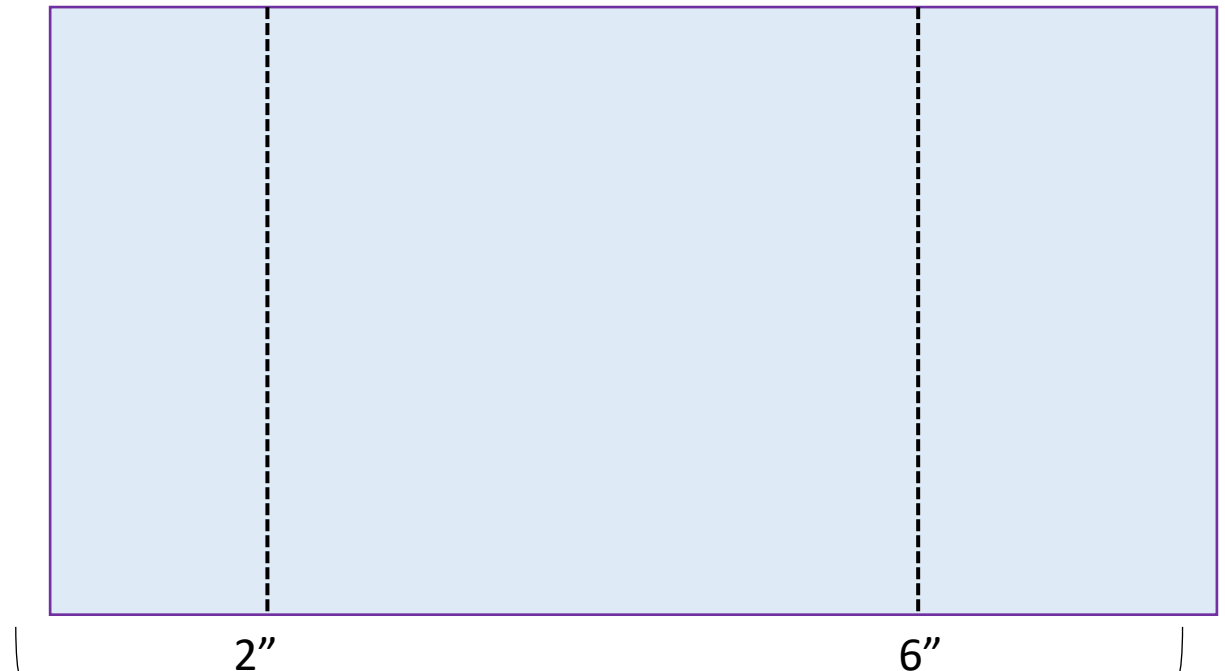
1. Cut a card front to $5\frac{1}{2} \times 8$ "
2. Score at 2 and 6 inches along the 8" side.
3. Cut two strips $3\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{4}$ "
4. Cut two small strips at 5×1 ". Score at 1, $2\frac{1}{2}$, and $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Assembly:

1. Fold the card base gatefold style. Adhere one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip along the left hand side panel. Adhere the other along the right hand side panel.
2. Fold all the score lines on the 5×1 " strip the same direction. Fold in half and position inside the card where you want it. Make sure the fold is facing towards the middle of the card and the first 1×1 " section is on top.
3. Place glue on the last section of the strip ($1\frac{1}{2} \times 1$ ") and place down in place again. Put glue on the 1×1 " section, which should be facing you, and then close the card. Give it a minute to adhere.
4. Embellish the card as desired.

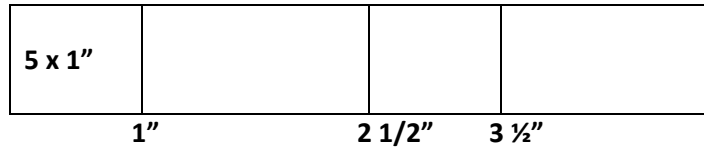
Basic Crossover Pop Up Card Template

Landscape:

5. Cut a card front to $4 \frac{1}{8}$ (or $4 \frac{1}{4}$) x 11"
6. Score at $2 \frac{3}{4}$ and $8 \frac{1}{4}$ inches along the 11" side.
7. Cut two strips $5 \times 1 \frac{3}{4}$ "
8. Cut two small strips at 5×1 ". Score at 1, $2 \frac{1}{2}$, and $3 \frac{1}{2}$ "

Assembly:

5. Fold the card base gatefold style. Adhere one $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip along the left hand side panel. Adhere the other along the right hand side panel.
6. Fold all the score lines on the 5×1 " strip the same direction. Fold in half and position inside the card where you want it. Make sure the fold is facing towards the middle of the card and the first 1×1 " section is on top.
7. Place glue on the last section of the strip ($1 \frac{1}{2} \times 1$ ") and place down in place again. Put glue on the 1×1 " section, which should be facing you, and then close the card. Give it a minute to adhere.
8. Embellish the card as desired.
