Stamps: Peaceful Season

Ink: Whisper White Craft Ink, Pebbled

Path

**Cardstock:** Gray Granite, Cherry Cobbler, Pebbled Path, Basic White

Accessories: Cherry Cobbler Ribbon,

**Drusy Embellishments** 

Tools: Peaceful Season Dies, Painted Trees

Embossing Folder, Sponge Dauber



## **Pebbled Path:**

4 1/8 x 11"

## **Cherry Cobbler:**

3 7/8 x 5 ½" (2) 5 ½ x ½"

#### **Basic White:**

 $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 5 \frac{1}{8}$ " Scrap for label

# **Gray Granite:**

5 ½ x 3 ¾"

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Fold the Pebbled Path in half to create the card base. Emboss the Gray Granite piece with the Painted Trees folder.
- 2. Ink up a sponge dauber with Whisper White ink and lightly dab over the trees to bring out the pattern. Let dry. (Shouldn't take more than a few minutes).
- 3. Adhere the two Cherry Cobbler strips along each side of the Gray Granite piece. Stamp the words from Peaceful Season in Pebbled Path on Basic White. Die cut with the Peaceful Season dies. Adhere to the Gray Granite panel with Dimensionals.
- 4. Cut two 4" pieces of the Cherry Cobbler ribbon and slip each through either side of the label. Wrap the ends around the back of the panel and secure with tape. Adhere this entire piece to the card base.
- 5. Use about 10" of ribbon and tie a bow around one side of the ribbon. Add three Drusy embellishments to finish.
- 6. Adhere the remaining two panels to the inside of the card.
