



## Basic Waterfall Card Template

1. Cut a card front to  $5 \frac{1}{4} \times 3 \frac{7}{8}$ ".
2. Cut a small strip of cardstock  $1 \frac{1}{8} \times 3 \frac{7}{8}$ ".
3. Cut the waterfall mechanism out of cardstock to  $7 \frac{1}{2} \times 2$ ", scored at  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ,  $5 \frac{1}{4}$ , and  $6$ ".
4. Cut three cardstock squares at  $2 \frac{1}{4} \times 2 \frac{1}{4}$ ".

### Assembly:

1. Fold all the score lines the same direction.
2. Adhere section 1 of the scored piece to the middle of piece #1. Fold so section #4 is behind piece #1, and the three section with the score lines are in front of piece #1.
3. Place this entire piece to the card front, positioning as you wish. Do not use any adhesive under the moving mechanism. Adhere on either end of piece #1 only. You can use a thin strip of strong tape or attach the card front with brads. Adhere this entire piece to a card base.
4. Add a piece of tape on sections 1, 2, and 3, placing the tape at the top, near the score line. Attach each of the  $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " cardstock squares to each section, starting at the bottom and ending with the top one. Embellish.
